Tours will be led by project specialists at each Santa Clara River restoration site.

At the first site, come learn how the City of Santa Clarita is working with partners and the community on a comprehensive plan to remove invasive giant reed (Arundo donax) and restore the Santa Clara River (SCR) watershed.

The second stop will be at the Cienega Springs Ecological Reserve where 283 acres of degraded river channel and floodplain are being restored through a mosaic of wetland and riparian habitat. This project is also improving public access to the Santa Clara River.
